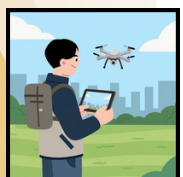
Foreign Risk Clinic

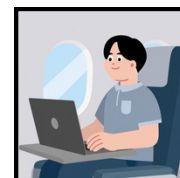
