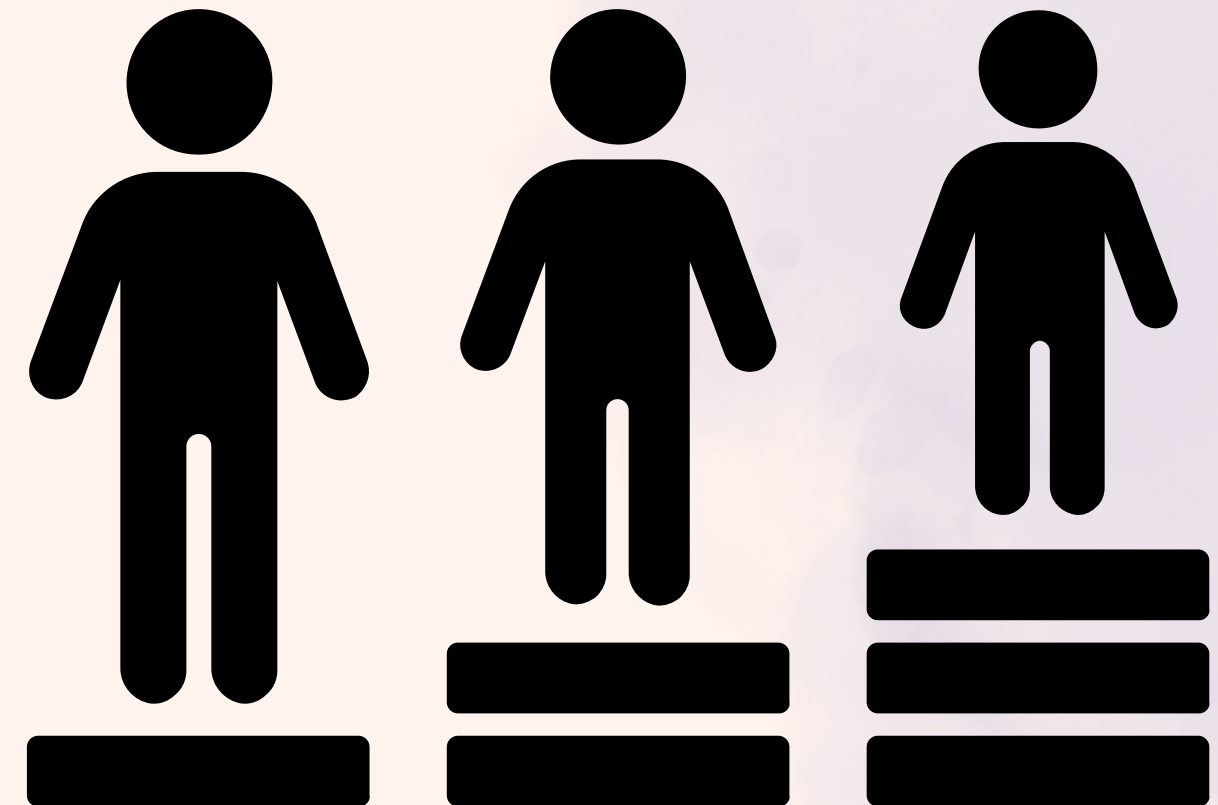

► Groups

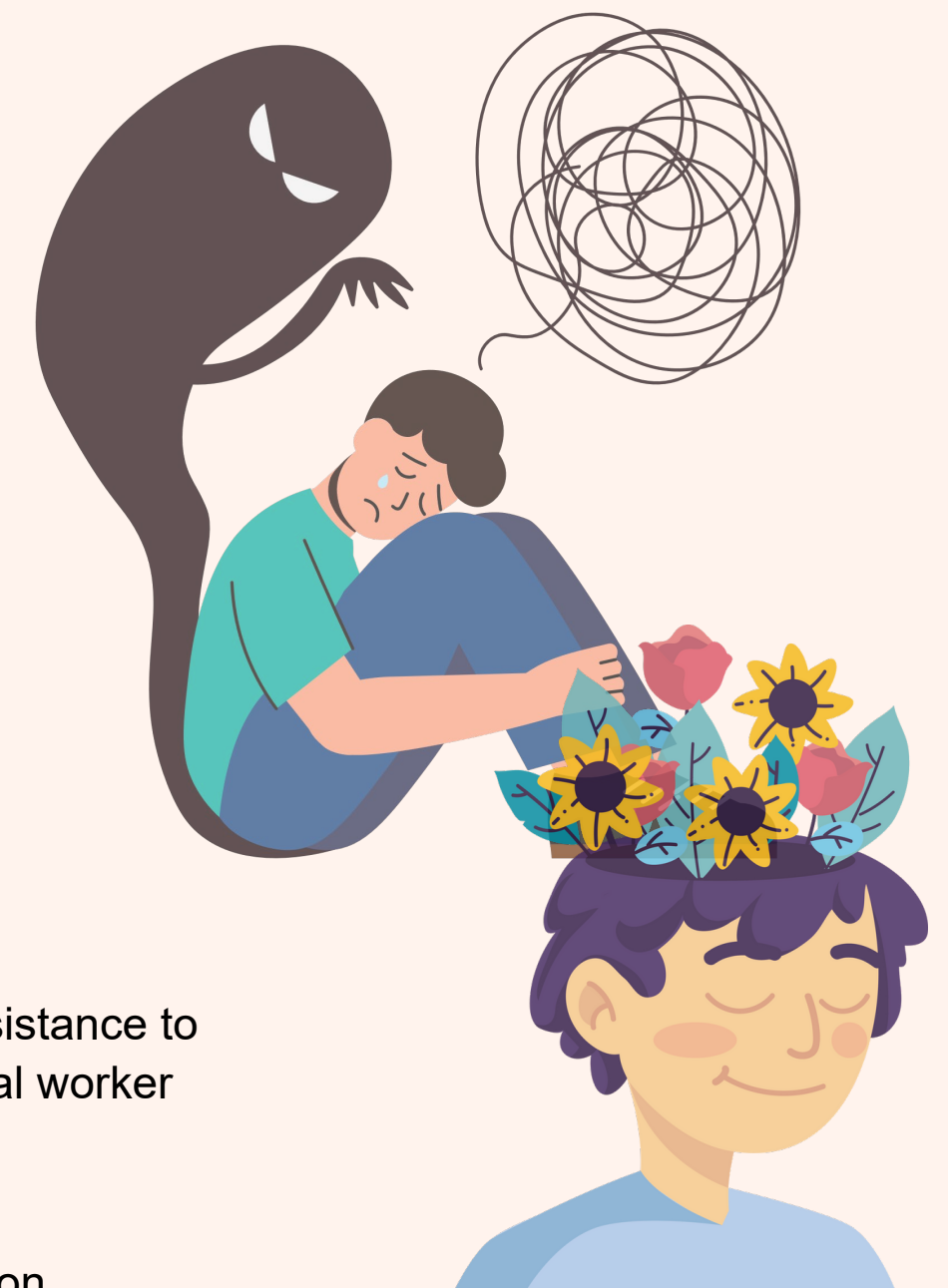
ADHD Support Groups, HDR Support Groups (pending), Working Through Procrastination
